

ROAD TRIP CHECKLIST FOR FOOD ALLERGIES

To help you prepare to travel with food allergies, review this list before your trip!

| Medications and Forms | 0000 | Check the expiration date of epinephrine auto-injectors Have extra medication on hand Print and pack Food Allergy and Anaphylaxis Emergency Care Plan Fill out and print chef card |

| Traveling | | Pack safe snacks or meals Bring wipes for surfaces and hands Be sure everyone knows what to do in case of an emergency |
| Restaurants | | Research dining options along your route Call restaurants ahead and ask to speak to a manager or chef about their policies for managing food allergies |
| Hotels | | Find accommodations with a microwave and refrigerator so that you can safely warm up and store safe foods Perform a visual inspection of your room upon arrival for loose food or residue Determine where the nearest emergency department is in case a reaction occurs |
| Hosts | | Have a conversation with your hosts in advance to ensure they understand your food allergy safety rules |
